



Loup River Public Power District (LPPD) is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Vice President of Engineering.

Position Summary:

The Vice President of Engineering has leadership accountability for all components associated with the planning, design, maintenance and construction of utility installations dealing with the electric, transmission, distribution and generation systems as well as various associated buildings and structures. This position has significant supervisory responsibility for Engineering and Meter/Maintenance personnel whose performance of duties directly impact the planning and design of the District's electric and generation systems and all regulatory issues of the Hydro system.

Experience/Education:

Essential Job Functions:

- Provide supervisory direction, guidance, coaching, and oversight for the recruitment, selection, orientation, and retention of a qualified engineering and meter/maintenance workforce; prepare paperwork, regular feedback, and conduct meetings pertaining to the work performance of his/her direct reports; review time sheets for accuracy and submit for processing; lead selection interviews for in-house transfers as needed
- Work with Operations personnel to arrive at solutions for specific details on problems that may arise for design and construction of District generation, transmission and distribution systems
- Plan and design the District's power and generation systems to meet projected and actual system requirements
- Develop, communicate, and distribute construction standards and engineering assistance in response to other department requests
- Prepare District construction project budgets and associated work orders with Operations department personnel
- Direct, coordinate, and monitor the work of outside contractors and consultants according to project budgets, schedules, estimates and specifications
- Oversee the preparation and maintenance of maps and officials records for the District operating department and/or other departments upon request
- Prepare and/or obtain from utilities or government subdivision all records, permits, contracts or agreements necessary for the construction and/or operation of the District's power facilities
- Adhere to and enforce all regulatory compliance particularly FERC requirements as they impact the hydroelectric system, including administration of the High Hazard Area Safety Program.
- Oversee the performance of inspections at various facilities to analyze proper operation and assess status of facility conditions
- Attend all Board meetings

About LPPD:

- Loup River Public Power District corporate office is located in Columbus, Nebraska. The District employs 120 employees and has a nine-person Board of Directors. Loup serves about 21,000 customers in Boone, Colfax, Nance and Platte Counties and part of Madison County. LPPD owns and operates two hydro plants that generate over 150,000 MWh annually. LPPD owns, operates and maintains five parks containing 77 acres of land and 1,100 acres of water. LPPD's annual revenue is approximately \$100 million.
