Applications Requested for an Apprentice Lineman/Lineman

Butler Public Power District "District" is currently seeking applicants for the position of an Apprentice Lineman/Lineman. This position will be located at the District Headquarters at 1331 N 4th Street, David City, NE, and the successful applicant must reside within 13 miles of the District Office. District serves over 6,600 customers and has over 1,700 miles of power lines located in Butler and western Saunders Counties, Nebraska.

Job Specifications:

Apprentice Lineman/Lineman applicant must have completed an approved lineman course. Applicants must have Class A CDL license. Must consent to the pre-employment query from the Federal Drug & Alcohol Clearinghouse. A physical examination including drug and alcohol screening is required after job offer is made and prior to starting date.

Job Knowledge:

Must acquire a working knowledge of construction, maintenance, and service of Transmission & Distribution facilities within a reasonable time span as determined by the District. Must learn and practice District's Safety Rules and Procedures. Must learn RUS Materials and the National Electric Safety Code as required for each phase of the apprenticeship/lineman program. Must be or become certified in First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and obtain Certified Switchman Training.

Abilities and Skills:

Position requires climbing utility poles and/or standing in a hydraulic bucket for construction/maintenance duties and URD construction/maintenance duties. Through the apprenticeship/lineman program one must demonstrate proficiency in pole top rescue yearly. Frequently moves and/or carries materials and equipment weighing up to 75 pounds.

Working Conditions:

Irregular hours include nights, weekends, and holidays. Overtime is required. Also be able to work under adverse weather conditions such as extreme heat or cold, high winds or stormy conditions.
