

Custer Public Power District currently has an opening for an **Operations Manager**.

This position is responsible for the daily operations of the District, which include coordinating and directing the area construction and maintenance crews, and all associated paperwork. Considerable care is required to ensure accurate District records. Work must be prepared promptly and deadlines met. Considerable customer contact is required as well as the ability to appropriately identify, solve and respond to their needs. The work requires math skills as well as concentration, analytical and problem solving skills, independent judgement, discretion, initiative and considerable knowledge of company policies and routines.

The qualified applicant will possess leadership and supervisory skills including but not limited to budgetary control, supervision, delegation, evaluation and employee discipline and documentation. The individual will be responsible for the safety culture of the District, which includes an on-going, active safety program for all employees.

A high school diploma or GED is required. A bachelor's degree in a related field is desirable. Ten years experience in the maintenance and operation of electric transmission and distribution systems and substations will be equivalent to a college degree.

This position will work out of the Broken Bow, Nebraska Headquarters Office, but there will be extensive field work. Some irregular hours will be required which may include nights, weekends, and emergencies. Travel will be required both in and outside the system.

This position is open to employees of Custer Public Power and the general public.
