### NREA YOUTH ENERGY LEADERSHIP CAMP

Camp is available to children and grandchildren of managers, directors, and employees of any NREA member-system. Participants do not need to reside in the same district territory as the manager, director, or employee. Participants need to be a freshman, sophomore or junior in high school. Camp is a five -day camp and will be held on July 21-25, 2025, at Camp Comeca in Cozad, NE. Youth are able to take

part in hands-on learning and leadership, learning about electricity, power generation, and the rural electric industry. They enjoy tours at the Kingsley Dam at Lake McConaughy and the Gerald Gentleman Station at Sutherland as well as activities like rock climbing, adventure course, swimming, basketball, and volleyball. After attending the camp, they may be able to come back the next year and be a volunteer camp counselor. If they want to go one step further, there is an ambassador competition that could earn them a fully funded trip to Washington, D.C. Making new friends that could last a lifetime is sure to take place. If you have a child or grandchild interested in attending, they can learn more by contacting your rural electric company.
