



Camp Scholarships for the Children and Grandchildren of Rural Electric Employees and Directors



The Women in Rural Electrification (WIRE) organization will sponsor eight scholarships for high school age students to attend this year's Youth Energy Leadership Camp, scheduled for July 20-24, 2026. WIRE Scholarships are open to any child or grandchild of an employee or director of a NREA Member-System. Scholarships will cover all camp participation costs.

WIRE Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

1. Applicant must be a child or grandchild of an employee or director of a NREA Member-System.
Note: the applicant does not need to reside in a Member-System's service area.
2. Applicant must currently be a freshman, sophomore, or junior in high school.

How to Apply

Applicants must submit a resume that identifies their academic, club and/or social and community achievements along with a cover letter stating the reasons the applicant desires to attend camp.

Don't delay! WIRE applications are due at the NREA office no later than **May 8, 2026**. Notification of scholarship awards will be made by June 5, 2026.
