Responsible for maintaining necessary supply of parts and tools for shop. Assist in unloading freight as needed. General repair of District property. Assist in mowing and snow removal as needed. Water, AED, Fire Extinguisher testing, maintenance and documentation. Become and remain certified in CPR and first aid. A minimum Class A commercial driver's license. Must be able to: carry and lift up to 50 pounds, be able to climb, bend, reach, and lift while in awkward positions, to work off of a mechanics creeper while laying on back, stand on concrete floor for several hours at a time. Must have a high emphasis on safety.

Will need to acquire and obtain Water Operator certification.
